ADRIAN BAILEY MP:

▶ Has spoken in 47 debates in the last year – well above average among MPs

▶ Has asked most questions about: Departments – Health; Business, Enterprise and Regulatory Reform; Home Department; Environment Food & Rural Affairs, Northern Ireland. Subjects – Health Action Zones; special constables; mobile phones (schools); carbon emissions, Criminal Records Bureau

▶ Is a member of two select committees: **European Scrutiny (since November 2007)** and **Business, Enterprise and Regulatory Reform (since November 2007)**

▶ Has voted in 93 per cent of votes in parliament – well above average among MPs

▶ Has asked 33 oral questions to Members of the Government
