"Our safety and security are vital. I have spoken in Parliament in support of ID cards and extra time to interview suspected terrorists. I believe that the criminal justice system should support the victim and not the criminal. That is why I am supporting measures to speed up the criminal justice system and am pressing the Home Secretary for there to be more attention on business crime."

During the parliamentary summer recess Adrian spent 20 days working with the West Midlands Police, taking part in dawn raids on drug dealers and a suspected armed robber, walking the beat with community safety officers and studying high tech crime.
